

EXTENDED INFORMATION NOTICE ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA THROUGH VIDEO SURVEILLANCE SYSTEM

(pursuant to GDPR 679/2016; the National Data Protection Laws, as well as the General Provision on video surveillance, of 8 April 2010, issued by the Italian Data Protection Authority – the "Authority" – and Article 4 of Law no. 300/1970)

FONDAZIONE CASSA DI RISPARMIO DI CUNEO with registered office at **17, Via Roma – 12100 Cuneo (CN) – Tax Code 96031120049** as Data Controller, pursuant to art. 13 of EU Regulation no. 679/2016, as well as by virtue of the Provision of the Italian Data Protection Authority on video surveillance of 8 April 2010 and the multilevel procedure dictated by art. 4 of the Workers' Statute, informs that in order to ensure the protection of property and persons, as well as for the prevention and effective prosecution of crimes, video surveillance equipment has been installed at the headquarters, the cameras of which are duly indicated with appropriate signs.

❑ PURPOSE AND LEGAL BASIS OF DATA PROCESSING

Based on the legitimate interest of the Data Controller (Article 6, paragraph 1, letter f of GDPR 679/16) the processing of personal data (images taken) is necessary for:

- the protection of property and in particular the prevention of crimes against the assets of the Foundation, as well as its employees and users; defensive controls aimed at ascertaining the commission of crimes.

❑ DATA PROCESSING METHODS

The personal data collected and processed through the video surveillance system are the images of people and things that pass within the range of action of these systems.

The collection and processing of such data takes place in such a way as to guarantee the maximum security and confidentiality of the data subject. Specifically, the equipment will be in operation 24 hours a day, every day.

❑ STORAGE OF IMAGES

FONDAZIONE CASSA DI RISPARMIO DI CUNEO informs you that your personal data and recorded images will be processed and stored in a suitable place and in an appropriate manner, protecting their confidentiality, in compliance with current regulations and the principles of necessity, relevance and non-excessiveness in relation to the purposes pursued for a period equal to 72 hours from their collection, after which they will be deleted.

The images may be kept for a longer period of time in the event of holidays or closure of offices or businesses, as well as in the event that it is necessary to comply with a specific investigative request from the Judicial Authority or the judicial police. The legal basis is found in the fulfilment of a legal obligation to which the Data Controller is subject (Article 6, paragraph 1, letter c of GDPR 679/16).

❑ VIEWING OF IMAGES

The images collected and recorded will be processed exclusively by authorised personnel in charge of the video surveillance system. The images may also be processed by the managers of IT-technical services for the sole purpose of ensuring the correct functioning of the system itself.

❑ DISSEMINATION AND COMMUNICATION OF IMAGES

The images collected and recorded may be communicated to Bodies and/or Institutions in all cases indicated by legal obligations and in the event that it becomes necessary

to the Judicial and Public Security Authorities upon specific request.

Personal data acquired with video surveillance systems will not be disseminated in any way. The Data Controller does not transfer personal data to third countries or international organisations.

❑ RIGHTS OF THE DATA SUBJECT

Pursuant to GDPR 679/2016, the data subject has the right of access (Article 15) and the right to deletion of personal data concerning them (Article 17).

The interested party acknowledges that, in considering the intrinsic nature of the data gathered, the rights of rectification or integration cannot be exercised.

In order to assert their rights, the data subject may contact the Data Controller specifying the subject of their request, the right they intend to exercise, and attaching a photocopy of an identity document attesting to the legitimacy of the request to the following address:
